## TheraPlate Honors Exceptional Horses During Weeks III and IV of 2017 Colorado Summer in the Rockies Series

Wilcox and her winning mount have a long and special history together as a horse-and-rider team. The duo first met when J.E.S. Quito was an inexperienced youngster, and Wilcox herself was a working student. From the beginning, Wilcox took a keen interest in developing the young prospect, shouldering almost all the tasks of caring for, grooming, and training him. Over the years, the pair has developed a strong and successful partnership, eventually going on to earn their share of successes and competing together in the Grand Prix.

The second horse to garner the award from TheraPlate was Cumana, a Canadian warmblood bay gelding (Black Diamond x Step) owned and ridden by Little Rock Arkansas-based jumper Mattie Hatcher. Hatcher and Cumana rode to victory in the Adequan 1.40/1.45m Open Jumper Class during week IV of the summer competition series, claiming the blue ribbon just before accepting their award from TheraPlate.

Hatcher, who trains with Michael Tokaruk of Tokaruk Show Stables, is extremely pleased with Cumana's performance so far this year at the Colorado Horse Park.

"My other young rider horse got hurt, so I got Cumana to step up in the levels, and he has just exceeded all my expectations. He has scope beyond what you think a horse could have.

He is also very forgiving, and though he can be a little crazy outside the ring, he's awesome whenever you're on his back."

Hatcher, who was excited to accept her award from TheraPlate, has tried the TheraPlate before on herself, as well as tested it on some of her horses. "It makes my body feel like I just took an ice bath, and it relaxes your muscles. I think it would be really good for my horses because of all the pounding and stress on their joints, especially in their lower legs. Standing on the TheraPlate loosens them up."
