"In recent years, K2 and I have been through some life-threatening injuries together, and have had to learn to do things differently due to the injuries we received," explained Bagai, who operates Zeitgeist Equestrian in Petaluma, California. "He saved my life and kept me in the sport when I should have taken a very long break, and I saved his life when he was at his lowest. So to receive this award is very gratifying and gives both of us a boost to continue to persevere toward our goals; and for that we thank TheraPlate."

K2, a 15-year-old gelding piloted by Bagai, has seen not only his share of difficulties but also his share of top-level jumping competition. Bagai and K2 have competed in World Cup qualifiers, World Equestrian Games qualifiers, and the 2014 FEI World Equestrian Games in Normandy, France. The visually striking 18-hand grey was named after the Himalayan mountain K2 because of his impressive height.

Cricket, a dark bay, 17.1-hand Hanoverian, also demonstrated the soundness, conditioning, and athleticism that TheraPlate celebrates. Cricket showed that equine athletes produce strong performances when they feel good and are enjoying their work. Cricket and Van Uithoven, from Peoria, Illinois, placed second in the Medium Jr/AO Jumper 1.30m class at the Colorado Horse Park before accepting the TheraPlate Peak Performance Award.

Van Uithoven was delighted that her talented jumper was chosen as a Theraplate Peak Performance Award recipient. "The 1.30m class went pretty well! There were some rider errors – I didn't get him close enough to the jump, so he just didn't get across it like we would have wanted. But other than that, he was really good."

A recent college graduate who is beginning her career as an accountant with Ernst and Young in St. Louis, Missouri, Van Uithoven spends most weekends working with Shannon Hicks, head trainer and coach at Great Griffin Farm in Wentzville, Missouri.
