She has lived in Wellington, FL, since age 12, when her family moved from Pittsburgh, PA, so that she could pursue her dressage career. The move has paid off for this successful trainer and clinician, who hopes to represent her country internationally and continue training horses up the levels. Her work with top dressage trainers, such as Sasha Newman, Oded Shimoni, Marco Bernal, Caroline Roffman, and many other clinicians is showing, and she is currently training with IDA Farm's Jaime Amian of Spain and also Neve Myburgh of Germany.
