**Casey Deary Uses TheraPlate to Rein into Top Placings at the
2016 National Reining Breeders Classic**



Katy, TX (May 6, 2016) – In an odd twist at the recent 2016 National Reining Breeders Classic (NRBC), Casey Deary landed in a three-way tie for first place in the 2016 NRBC Open Classic Preliminaries and in a two-way tie for third place in the NRBC Open Classic Finals. His top placings at the NRBC came as no surprise to the reining world, as just months ago Deary also won the 2015 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Futurity Finals and simultaneously became an NRHA Million Dollar Rider.

At the NRBC competition at the Great Southwest Equestrian Center in Katy, Texas, Deary on In Like Flinn shared the first place title in the Open Classic Preliminaries with Jordan Larson and Jason Vanlandingham. They scored 225. Deary then tied for third with Andrea Fappani with a score of 229 in the Open Finals, behind Vanlandingham and Tom McCutcheon, respectively. What's perhaps most interesting about the final top placings at the NRBC is that three of the leading riders— Deary, McCutcheon, and Fappani— all use TheraPlate Revolution Therapy Platforms to keep their horses in winning condition.

In fact, Deary had three horses in the top 20 at the competition (In Like Flinn, Magnum Starlights, and Shesouttaylorleague) who all use TheraPlate, which is the Official Therapy Plate of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF).

“My horses use the TheraPlate daily before every ride,” said Deary. This means that more than 200 horses have used the TheraPlate as an integral part of their fitness and health maintenance at Deary Performance Horses since Deary first discovered the innovative machine. Deary has been showing reiners for 16 years. Most notably, Deary won the NRHA Reining Futurity in both 2012 and 2015, aboard two mares that were NRHA Million Dollar Earners. Deary currently operates Deary Performance Horses and lives with his wife, Nicole, and their four children in Weatherford, Texas.

Deary first discovered TheraPlate, which is also based in Weatherford, when his 2012 NRHA Open Futurity Championship mare, Americasnextgunmodel, incurred a suspensory injury.
